

RECORD OF PROCEEDINGS
FORT LUPTON ART IN PUBLIC PLACES COMMITTEE
Regular Meeting
Thursday, April 26, 2018

The Fort Lupton Art in Public Places Committee met at City Hall on Thursday, April 26, 2018. Chairperson Teri Kopfman called the meeting to order at 9:08 a.m.

ROLL CALL

Roll call was taken and those present were Teri Kopfman, Ysabel Molina, Kristel Acre and Carol Ruckel. Also in attendance was City Clerk Mari Pena .

APPROVAL OF AGENDA

It was moved by Ms Ruckel and seconded by Ms Molina that the Agenda be approved as presented. The motion carried unanimously.

APPROVAL OF CONSENT AGENDA

Approval of Minutes of March 15, 2018.

It was moved by Ms Ruckel and seconded by Ms Acre that the Consent Agenda be approved as presented. The motion carried unanimously.

PUBLIC AND VISITOR INPUT

There was no one present for public/visitor input.

DISCUSSION ITEMS

a. Cannery Park Dedication Review

Ms Pena will do a procedure for speakers at future events. She will give the cannery labels to Stacy Robinson (city) to see if the design could be used in Cannery Park's renovation. Ms Acre commented that the parks are looking good at this point in the spring. The bid for new equipment has been awarded.

b. Mission/Guidelines

No further comments were received on the draft document. Ms Ruckel noted that most cities devote 1% of a project/building cost to public art.

c. Horse with No Name

The boxes are ready; Ms Pena will handle the information sheet and printing the ballots, to be put in an attached envelope pocket. The committee set a deadline of May 15 so that they can review entries at the May 17 meeting and send its preferences on to Council. The dedication will be held June 11 at 5:30 at the golf course.

d. Tree Carving Update

No update. Ms Kopfman will share photos of carvings in Sterling, Colorado.

e. 4th of July Hand Painting at Skate Park

Ms Pena will ask Council for permission for this project on May 2.

f. Chalk Art Project

This project has been approved, to take place on the west side of Koshio Park. Police Department will purchase chalk as part of National Night Out activities.

g. Community Art Show

Ms Ruckel and Ms Molina attended the meeting with the Library staff about the Art Show. The library needs three months of lead time; with their displacement this summer for renovations, they would like late March/early April 2019. The opening reception was scheduled for March 22. The city will do the application, piece cards, ads, and check on insurance/waivers for applicants. The library will handle public relations, food, and equipment rental. Artists will need to hang their own work with committee assistance; there is no storage available at the library. A 5-6 week application period was recommended and artists can submit more than one work for consideration. Clear size limits will be set, with possible age groups: Kids, Youth, Adults. 80621 zip code plus Sweetgrass for the library's service area. "Fort Lupton Community Art Show" was selected as the name. Discussions will continue in the fall.

h. Project Dedication Markers

No update. A marker will be needed for the Horse With a Name.

i. Other Updates

Ms Acre reported that John Newton is fixing his flowers at 52 and Denver Ave; we may need to move those across the street to Ceretto's corner. Chris Cross and Nanette Fornoff have done a photo inventory of the committee's projects. They will share it with committee members. Ms Pena will ask Mr. Robinson about murals at the skate park.

Budget request for Skate Park and Tree Carving. Possible brochure of projects.
