Aug. 8, 2017

The CPR Committee of the City of Fort Lupton, met at the Community Center on Tuesday Aug. 8, 2017. Chairperson Ed Richmond called the meeting to order at 6:00pm.

Roll Call

Roll call was taken in writing. Those present were Chairperson Ed Richmond, Bill Griffiths, Reid Graves and Will Piper. Also present were Recreation Director Monty Schuman, and Building and Grounds Director Stacy Robinson.

Approval of Minutes

The minutes of the June 13, 2017 meeting were reviewed. Will Piper moved to approve and Reid Graves seconded and the minutes were approved.

Business

Monty reported that the youth sports league for the summer season were winding down. Baseball had ended and Softball was over for the youth. Adult Softball was also playing on Monday evenings and would be ending this week. Maintenance was scheduled for the Pool with the skylight being fixed and the islands and locker room showers being redone. It should take between 7 and 10 working days to get done. The upcoming event for Trappers Day were getting finalized. The 4th of July was a big success. A Sand Volleyball League was held this summer and the teams have asked for a fall league as well. The Fall Brochure is being put together and should be out later this month.

Stacey was at full staff for about 2 weeks. They will be helping with a pop-up park to be placed at Trappers Day between 1st and 2nd street on Denver. Tree painting has been completed in a number of the parks. A sculpture is planned to be placed on the berm in front of the Rec Center. Little Libraries have been installed around town. The right-of-way for the trail is being finalized and this should be ready to proceed. Parks has purchased a new mower with a broom attachment to help with snow removal. Parks are also taking pre bids for tree pruning. Welcome signs have been installed, The Sauld Picnic is scheduled for this Friday. The Outdoor Concert for the 18th is gearing up and will be held in the back of the Park Shop on the soccer fields.

Ed questioned why the art committee is not part of the CPR Committee. He also brought up Handicapped parking issues.

The Ice Cream social at the museum is planned for Trappers Day as in the past. A new Avon exhibit will be starting later this month.
